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Choosing a Program

Picking the right early education and care program for your child is an important task. Local choices include family childcare, centerbased childcare, parent co-ops and public schools. There are many licensed providers in Falmouth and Mashpee. For the most up-todate list, visit the Early Education & Care website: www.mass.gov/orgs/ department-of-early-education-and-care

Visiting several programs can help in the decision making process. Ask as many questions as you need to, to ensure a good fit. Things to keep in mind when choosing a provider:

- Provider qualifications (education and experience)
- Hours of operation
- Cost and payment policies
- Holidays/vacation policies
- Food/meals provided
- Schedule of activities
- Nap time policies
- Communication with caregivers
- Safety and medical policies
- Behavioral management policies

While your child is enrolled in a program, it is essential to communicate with the provider. Be sure to let them know how your child is doing at home and if you have any questions or concerns, be sure to address them immediately.

Serves children birth to 3 years old who have developmental delay or disabilities, or who are at risk for developmental concerns. All families are entitled to a developmental evaluation to determine eligibility which is billed to insurance or the Department of Public Health, with no cost to the family.





Like a map for your child's developmental journey, the Ages & Stages Questionnaire® (ASQ) is designed reveal your child's strengths, uncover any areas of concern and find out if there are

community resources or services that may useful for your child or your family. It contains a series of questions designed for your child's age group (1 month to 5½ years) which can be answered in 10-15 minutes and scored immediately.

Why is it important for my child to be screened?

Screening helps you understand your child's development and know what to look for next in important areas like communication, social skills, motor skills, and problem-solving skills.

Can a questionnaire really capture my child's skills and progress? Yes! Studies have shown that parent-completed screening tools like ASQ® are very effective at pinpointing progress. It calls for your unique perspective on how your child behaves and performs skills in natural settings like your home. That means it can capture the big picture of your child's development better than a screening that takes place in an unfamiliar setting.
